

# PrEP TALK

## FACTS, TIPS & INFO ABOUT THIS NEW OPTION IN HIV PREVENTION

- PrEP is a safe, legal, effective option for preventing HIV
- When taken every day, PrEP is more than 90% effective at preventing HIV
- PrEP protects against HIV but not against other STDs
- PrEP can be prescribed by any health care provider
- With PrEP you are in control of prevention. There is no negotiating. The choice is yours.
- PrEP means you are protected and so are your clients and partners
- Going on PrEP means being regularly engaged in care, and that's good for health outcomes
- Healthcare is no longer tied to employment, and PrEP is covered by insurance providers
